#### **Home Horticulture Management Workshops**

Tree Management Workshop will be held on Thursday, May 30, 2013 from 6-8 p.m. at the Winkler-Loving AgriLife Extension Office.

With the arid climate that we have in West Texas, selection of the appropriate trees can improve water conservation and reduce the economic impacts involved with having to remove dead trees and replant new trees. Each year I receive a number of calls from homeowners concerned about the trees growing in their yards. These questions range from trees with freeze damage to trees showing the effects of freeze damage and drought. Through this program I will provide some of the common symptoms associated with trees in our area, as well as ways to prevent and treat these issues. We will also be covering nutritional needs of trees and water conservation methods that can be implemented without damaging the health and appearance of trees.
